

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY #19

RE: Fee for Field Driver

The owner of any domestic animal, except a dog or cat, which is at large and not under the direct supervision and control of an owner or keeper will be responsible for payment of a \$15.00 fee per incident.

The \$15.00 fee will be applicable when no one is physically present where the animals are kept at the time of the incident or a person present is incapable of taking charge of the animals, or when the owner or keeper is not known to the enforcing individual.

This fee will be payable directly to the Field Driver as compensation for his or her response, or to the Town of Seekonk when enforced by a law enforcement officer.

The owner or keeper of such loose domestic animals will be responsible for payment of an additional fee of \$15.00 if the animals are taken into custody and impounded. Said fee will be payable to the Field Driver for his or her compensation for removal and impoundment of the animals.

The owner of impounded animals will be responsible for the board fees of said animals, payable to the Impounder at the time of release of said animals. The fee for board will be \$4.00 per animal per day, except for fowl for which board will be \$1.00 per day per bird.

The owner of said loose domestic animals will be responsible for all damages to property, public and private, while at large, and such damages will be collected as per Chapter Forty-nine of the General Laws.
