Discussion	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Jim asked council members if they needed any more grave marker flags, as he had previously passed them out for replacing worn flags on KIA monuments. Over the last couple of months, he has replaced flags twice at the monument at the intersection of Routes 44 and 114A. The flags were not damaged, they were missing...very unusual.2. Jim discussed a proposal that was sent to the town clerk regarding signs that had QR codes that link to historical information, i.e., information on a KIA. It was agreed upon that if we every had the need for something like this, we could design our own signs.3. Jim suggested that the council assign a Public Affairs Officer, since we haven't been great, as a council, at documenting our events with pictures and video. Joe volunteered to become our PAO, which works out great because he has already been creating our posters.

Discussion	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Mo's new tree vendor, Al-Jac's, is turning out to be a great choice. The vendor said that last year's premium 5-6 foot trees cost him \$22 apiece. He thinks they might be a couple of dollars more this year, but he will provide them to us at cost – since we are a veterans organization. This will significantly increase our profit margin per tree.2. Another great benefit to this supplier is that we don't have to lock in a set number of trees. He orders 3,000 trees, so we can adjust as we go along.3. It is also a lot closer location (Providence – near the VA hospital, as opposed to West Greenwich).4. Russ and Bill will pick up the trees on Friday, November 28th. So, Saturday, NOV 29th, will be the installation date. The tree lighting will be on Saturday, December 6th from 3:00-4:30pm. (Santa arrives at 3:15 and trees lit at 4:15).5. The trees will be removed on Saturday, January 3rd.6. Bill can lock in Santa, as he goes to his church. He'll also ask about borrowing a chair for Santa again.7. Jim will lock in the antique fire truck with Bill George.8. Bill handed out new maps of the tree layout. He'll get with DPW to mark the spots ahead of time.
