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THE COA PRIVACY LAW

Effective May 22, 2002, the Massachusetts COA Privacy Law shields from disclosure as a “public record” all identifying information about elderly persons, including client names and addresses, and other “information the disclosure of which may constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.” The COA Privacy Law does not distinguish between data records and oral communications. As a general rule, therefore, COA client-specific data/records/information should be regarded as confidential and treated with the utmost sensitivity to personal privacy.
