Chairman Wallace & Commission Members,

On behalf of Jarred & Linda Minieri (Applicant), Ecosystem Solutions, Inc. (ESI) respectfully submits this update on restoration plans currently being prepared by E. Otis Dyer, detailing changes made to those plans at the behest of the Seekonk Conservation Commission.

Due to unforeseen personal issues experienced by all parties during the months of July and August, coordinating and communicating changes that needed to be added to a proposed conditions/restoration plan was unachievable in time to be presented at the scheduled Aug. 16<sup>th</sup> meeting. We apologize to the Commission for this unexpected delay. However, we are expecting those plans to be completed shortly, and can give a written description of the proposed changes.

In addition to the previously discussed restoration efforts, two additional elements have been added. At the request of the Commission, a split rail fence with conservation signage will be placed approximately along the 90' contour line between the Property line with Map 21/Lot 297 and the existing lawn. In addition, a retaining wall with a safety fence along the top will be located again approximately along the 90' contour line between existing concrete steps at the north corner of the house and the Cul-de-Sac. Both of these items will be outside the delineated wetland line. Construction details of the retaining wall are to be determined, and will be presented to the Commission in a future plan when finalized. These additions to the restoration plan will create a physical barrier to protect the wetland resource areas for the foreseeable future.

We hope this letter shows that efforts are being made to incorporate the wishes of the Conservation Commission in a timely manner, and that we hope to have full resolution to this issue in the near future. As soon as the updated plans are available, they will be made available to the Commission. Please do not hesitate to reach out with any questions or concerns the Commission or Agent may have.
